





Guide to Recycling/Garbage

Materials		What to Place in Recycling Box	What to Place in Trash
 <p>Newspaper, Magazines & Catalogs</p>	<p>Anything that comes with your regular newspapers. Magazines delivered to your home or purchased at a newsstand. All catalogs, phone books, bound books, junk mail.</p>	<p>Place in paper bag in your bin.</p> <p>DO NOT USE STRING OR PLASTIC BAGS</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper, wrapping paper, pizza boxes.</p> <p>ANY FOOD SOILED PAPER</p>
 <p>Corrugated Cardboard</p>	<p>Recycle all brown corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, box board (shoe boxes, gift boxes, cereal boxes).</p>	<p>Remove all tape, staples, and strapping. Break down all boxes in 3 ft X 3 ft sections.</p> <p>Small pieces in brown bags.</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Wax corrugated, cardboard lined with foam, cores from carpet rolls or any item made of laminated sheets of paper or cardboard</p> <p>PIZZA BOXES</p>
 <p>Glass Bottles</p>	<p>All clear, green, and brown food and beverage containers ONLY.</p>	<p>Wash containers. Remove lids and caps. Labels DO NOT have to be removed. Put all containers and METAL lids and caps in recycling box.</p> <p>DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Ceramic bottles and other ceramic items, flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, mirror and window glass, heat resistant ovenware, hypodermic syringes, and eyeglasses.</p>
 <p>Metal/Aluminum</p>	<p>All metal food & beverage containers (cans/soda cans), metal lids, closure caps, aluminum pie tins. Aluminum food trays.</p>	<p>Wash containers. Remove lids and caps. Labels do not have to be removed.</p> <p>DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Propane cylinders, silverware, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice or motor oil) small appliances, metal cookware, tin foil, or hypodermic needles. All plastic caps, paint cans, toys, gutters, paint cans, automotive parts.</p> <p>DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TYPE OF BATTERY</p>
 <p>Plastic Numbers 1-7</p>	<p>All rinsed milk jugs, beverage, windshield washer fluid, butter, bleach, detergent, cool whip, cottage cheese and plant pot containers. Flip top lids, gable top milk and juice cartons.</p>	<p>Wash containers.</p> <p>NO styrofoam, NO deli-containers, NO microwave containers.</p> <p>Flatten jugs if possible.</p> <p>DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Antifreeze or motor oil containers (because of residue), furniture, plates, plastic bags, tableware, medicine bottles, plexiglass, fast food containers, snack bags, containers even if they are labeled with the recycling symbol, or Tupperware.</p> <p>Return plastic bags to Tops or Wegmans.</p>
 <p>Milk Cartons, Juice Cartons & Drink Boxes</p>	<p>Gable top beverages. Containers including those with plastic spouts. Remove lids.</p>	<p>Rinse and empty, place in recycling bin with other containers.</p> <p>DO NOT mix cartons with newspaper or corrugated cardboard.</p>	<p>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</p> <p>Straws from drink boxes.</p> <p>Frozen food containers.</p> <p>Waxed paper or drink pouches.</p>

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR RECYCLING BIN IS VISIBLE FOR COLLECTION.
